"MAKA Spezialwerk Für Feine Rasierklingen" in Fuschl (Salzburg)-Austrian company closed after World War II. At the end of the 1930s, it also launched production in Prague, Czech Republic (at that time the Third Reich). After the end of the war, the "Maka" factory in Czechoslovakia continued to produce razor blades for a long time.

Razor blades under the names "Del Monte" and "Metro" were also produced in Austria. In Czechoslovakia, apart from these, were also brands: "Horymir", "Roxy", "Well" or "Kleopatra"
