John Watts (Sheffield & London) Ltd
 R. Watts marketed a safety razor in the
 1890s. This was well before Gillette
 appeared on the scene and it is tempting to
 claim that Watts was a pioneer. However,
 although he may have been the first to
 market such a razor in Sheffield, his
 various models – marked 'JW' – were
 based on American patents.

Watts later produced safety razors with
 the trade mark 'THE GLEANER'.

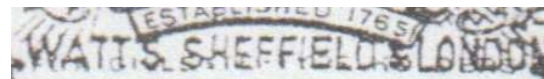
